## 4 Days Taipei Shopping & Hot Spring Package

### Day 1: Singapore – Taipei

Depart from Singapore Changi International Airport (own arrangement) and begin your holiday in Taipei. Upon arrival at Tao Yuan C.K.S International Airport, you will be meet and greet by our local tour representative and transferred to hotel. Free at own leisure after hotel check-in.

### Day 2: Taipei (B)

Enjoy a full day sightseeing tour after breakfast to see some of the most popular sights in Taipei. First visit the grandiose [Chiang Kai Shek Memorial Hall](#), in downtown Taipei to pay homage to the late President Chiang Kai-Shek. This majestic hall towers over 25 hectares of landscaped gardens, graceful pavilions, and ponds. Follow by the [Martyrs' Shrine](#) to see an excellent example of classical Ming Dynasty architecture dedicated to the fallen war heroes of the country and see the hourly changing of the guard ceremony. You will have the opportunity to see the colorful ceremony of the changing of the guard at the entrance.

The tour continues to the [National Palace Museum](#), which houses the world's largest and most valuable collection of Chinese art treasures. There are permanent displays of ceramics, bronzes, oracle bones, porcelain, paintings, calligraphy, enamelware, jade, Ching dynasty costume, carvings, and cabinets, as well as temporary exhibitions of other items.

The tour then takes you to one of the many traditional [Chinese temples](#) that surround Taipei city and [Handicraft Centre](#), which offers Taiwanese craftsmanship including jewelry, art and furniture and many others inexpensive mementos and follow by the quaint little village of [Chiufen Village](#) (Jiufen), once the gold mining center of Taiwan. The gold is now gone, but Chiufen (Jiufen) was built of closely-packed houses clinging to steep mountainsides, continue to offer enchanting scenery, unique teahouses and fascinating glimpses into the lifestyles of the past. You will see the old fashioned way of lifestyle is still existing here with the aura of an old mining that still apparent, Chiufen radiates a variety of emotions. You may also try some of its famous local dish like Taro and Sweet Potato Balls too.

Before heading to Shihlin Night Market, one of the largest night markets in Taipei, which draws massive crowds every night, especially for those looking for traditional foods and bargain prices on all kind of goods, soak yourself in one of the largest [Hot Spring](#) baths in the Taipei. You will be transferred back to your hotel at the end of the tour.

### Day 3: Taipei (B)

Today, you are free to explore Taipei City (own expenses) after breakfast at the hotel.

Visit the Miramar Entertainment Park (where many Taiwanese drama scenes take place), which is a comparable site in Taipei City beside the rotating Odaiba Ferris Wheel in Tokyo, a famous spot for Japanese young couples. Take a ride and enjoy the gigantic Ferris wheel in Miramar Entertainment Park to experience the romantic atmosphere.

Or you may want to visit the world's tallest building, Taipei 101; an outstanding landmark is enough to transform a city. Similar to the Empire State Building in New York or Eiffel Tower in Paris, Taipei 101 represents local excellence in architecture, which is influential enough to alter a city's style and features. With a towering 508 meters height, Taipei 101 stands at the heart of the Xinyi Planning District near Taipei World Trade Center with a global ambition and mission to lead Taipei City in shining over the entire world follow by shopping at Ximending, a shopping district, which symbolizes the urban life in Taipei.

### Day 4: Taipei - Singapore (B)

Free at your leisure after breakfast at the hotel till your departure transfer to Tao Yuan C.K.S International Airport for flight to Singapore.
