## 3 Days Phnom Penh Free & Easy

### Day 1: Singapore ✈ Phnom Penh

Depart from Singapore Changi International Airport (own arrangement) and begin your holiday in Cambodia. Upon arrival at Phnom Penh International Airport, you will be meet and greet by our local tour representative and transferred to the hotel. After hotel check-in, rest of the day free at own leisure.

### Day 2: Phnom Penh (B)

Today, you are free to explore the ancient city after breakfast at the hotel.

### Day 3: Phnom Penh ✈ Singapore (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Free at leisure till your departure transfer to the airport for flight to Singapore.

## 3 Days Phnom Penh Tour

### Day 1: Singapore ✈ Phnom Penh (L/D)

Depart from Singapore Changi International Airport (own arrangement) and begin your holiday in Cambodia. Upon arrival at Phnom Penh International Airport, you will be meet and greet by our local tour representative and transferred to the hotel. After hotel check-in, visit the **Independent Monument**, and **National Museum**, which is also called as Musee des Beaux-Arts. Follow by the **Royal Palace**, which was built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**, which was made up 5000 silver tiles that located within the grounds of the **Royal Palace**. After lunch at local restaurant, continue your journey to the **Wat Phnom** Temple, Phnom Penh's namesake, from where you can see the spectacular views of over the tree-lined avenues of the city. Then visit a well-known **NAGA World Casino** where you can visit & enjoy many games inside. Last but not least, you will end your day with the Sunset Cruise along Phnom Penh riverfront. A short cruise runs up the **Tonle Sap River** along the central riverfront area providing a picturesque view of the Royal Palace, National Museum, parks and Phnom Penh skyline, and then across the Tonle Sap and up the Mekong River to view floating fishing villages, which has become very popular nowadays. After dinner at local restaurant, transferred to the hotel.

**Remarks: Proper attire must be worn (no sleeveless tops, shorts & Bermudas) when visiting The Royal Palace and Silver Pagoda.**

### Day 2: Phnom Penh (B/L/D)

After breakfast at hotel, learn about a chapter from Cambodia's more recent, tragic, past at the **Tuol Sleng Museum** (Museum of Genocide). Formerly the Tuol Svay Prey High School, in 1975, this became the interrogation and torture facility for the Khmer Rouge regime - at that time known as Security Prison 21, or simply S-21. Kept largely unchanged, this prison now showcases photographs and exhibits about the thousands of victims that passed through these doors - only seven of whom came out alive and **Killing Fields of Choeung EK**, which is just 20-40mintues outside Phnom Penh, an orchard and a Chinese cemetery in 1975. Lunch at local restaurant, explore the modern-day city, visiting one of Phnom Penh's two great markets, the **Central Market**, located in a distinctive domed Art Deco building, or the sprawling Russian Market, a labyrinth of stalls that sell antiquities, silver and gold jewelry, gems, silk, kramas, stone and wood carvings, as well as T-Shirts, CDs and other souvenirs. Dinner will be served at local restaurant before returning hotel.

### Day 3: Phnom Penh ✈ Singapore (B)

Breakfast at hotel. Free at leisure till your departure transfer to the airport for flight to Singapore.
