### Day 1: Arrival at Melbourne

#### Full Day Sovereign Hill Tour

At Sovereign Hill, you can venture underground on a gold mine tour or catch a horse-drawn coach and tour the town. See steam-driven machinery in action and chat with wheelwrights, candlemakers and confectioners as they ply their trades. On the street and in the theatre, be entertained by costumed goldfields characters who are happy to pose for a great photo.

### Day 3: Melbourne

#### Full Day Great Ocean Road Scenery via Ocean Road

The Great Ocean Road spans 243km along the stunning coastline of Victoria's southwest. Take in the panoramic views as the road winds along cliff tops, up to breathtaking headlands, down onto the edge of beaches, across river estuaries and through lush rainforests. The stretch between Lorne and Apollo Bay is considered by many to be the most picturesque section of the Great Ocean Road. The most famous section of the Great Ocean Road features an amazing collection of rock formations known as the 12 Apostles which have been carved out of the headland by the fierce waves of the Southern Ocean.



### Day 4: Melbourne

#### Full Day Mt Dandenong and Puffing Billy Tour

The Dandenong Ranges are beautiful low mountain ranges just 35km east of Melbourne, cloaked in lush rainforests of Mountain Ash trees (the tallest flowering plant in the world), waterfalls, rolling hills and steep valleys. The region is home to the famous Puffing Billy Railway, numerous art and craft stores and cafes offering delicious homemade produce. Puffing Billy is the most fun way to tour the Dandenong Ranges. The rattling red carriages run across three historic timber bridges, uphill and down dale through valleys and plains filled with tree ferns and under the towering mountain ash, making a wonderful opportunity to relax and breathe in the fresh air whilst the train makes its way through the rainforest.
