Day 1: Arrival to Siem Reap (Lunch, Dinner)

Upon arrival to Siem Reap, you will be welcomed by our tour guide at the airport and brought on the tour.



- ❖ Begin your tour with a visit to the **Angkor Silk Farm** to understand the fascinating process of silk-making and buy high-quality silk products.
- ❖ Next, visit the **Les Artisan D' Angkor – Chantiers Ecoles**, a renowned woodworking, stone carving and polychrome workshop in Siem Reap.
- ❖ Proceed to the **Cambodian Cultural Village** after lunch. It houses 13 unique villages, each featuring different cultural heritages and traditions of Cambodia.

❖ Time to enjoy your dinner after the cultural tour before you check in to hotel for 3-night stay.

Day 2: Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Today, you will embark on a tour to discover the spectacular Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat regions.



- ❖ Start the day with a visit to the Angkor Thom area via the **South Gate of Angkor Thom**, the gateway to the ancient Great City.
- ❖ Inside the walls of this city, you will tour the **Bayon Temple**, standing in the exact centre of the city of Angkor Thom. It was built by the King Jayavarman VII dedicated to Buddhist.
- ❖ Located 200m northwest of the Bayon is the **Baphuon**, a single sanctuary temple-mountain situated on a high base.
- ❖ Then, visit the **Phimean Akas Temple**, located inside the enclosure of the Royal Palace of Angkor Thom north of Baphuon. It was built with roughly hewn sandstone blocks and has little decoration.

- ❖ Next, proceed to the **Elephants Terrace**, built in the late 12th century, dedicated to Buddhist and replica to the Bayon style of art.
- ❖ Afterwards, head to the **Leper King Terrace**, faced with dramatic bas-reliefs, and carries on the grandeur theme that characterizes the building during Jayavarman VII's reign.
- ❖ You will also tour the **Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond**, enclosed by a laterite wall with only the base remaining today.
- ❖ Following, visit the **Ta-Prohm Temple**, built in the Bayon style largely from late 12th to early 13th centuries. The photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surroundings have made the UNESCO World Heritage Site one of Angkor's most visited temples.

- ❖ After lunch, continue your journey to the largest religious monument in the world – the **Angkor Wat**. Built between the 9th and 13th century, this architectural masterpiece is one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world.
- ❖ Lastly, make a visit to **Phnom Bakheng** for its beautiful sunset.
- ❖ Transfer back to hotel after dinner for a good night's rest.



Day 3: Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



- ❖ This morning, enjoy a 1 and ½ hour boat ride on the **Tonle Sap Lake** to visit the floating village complete with schools, hospital, restaurants, Karaoke as well as the floating crocodile farm and Local Market. Afterwards, it is time for lunch.
- ❖ Next, visit the **Khmer Ceramic & Fine Arts Centre**, a social enterprise which provides employment and vocational training to the local people while reviving traditional Cambodian ceramic arts.
- ❖ Enjoy a **traditional Khmer massage** for 1 hour followed by an

interesting tour to the **Local Market**.

- ❖ Tonight, you will have dinner with an **Aspara Dance Performance** before returning to hotel to rest.
