

New Passenger Fee

The Government of Mauritius has introduced a passenger fee for all journeys not originating in Mauritius. This tax must be collected and implementation will take effect from 20 JANUARY 2005, and the details are:

Passengers category	Passengers whose journey originally starts from Reunion, Madagascar, Seychelles and Comoros	All other passengers
Children below 2 years	NIL	NIL
Children aged 2 and above but below 12 years	MUR150	MUR350
Passengers aged 12 years and above	MUR300	MUR700

Transit Passengers (<24 hours) are exempted.

The fee is to be collected at point of sale, and must be included on all tickets issued on or after this date.

Please note that, if this tax has not been included in the ticket, this amount will have to be paid on departure directly by clients at the airport.

IATA has been notified, and has assigned the code "HH", which will appear in fares quotes through the GDS.
