Day 1 Arrive in Kathmandu (Dinner)

Arrive in Kathmandu, you will be greeted by our local representative and be transferred to your hotel. Our representative will brief you about the trip and the time table. Check-in to the hotel and free & easy.

Day 2 Kathmandu – Chitwan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Morning begins with a hearty breakfast then drive to **Chitwan** (about 5hrs). Chitwan offers one of **the finest wildlife experiences in Asia**. Chitwan literally means "heart of the jungle" offering lush jungles and vibrant Tharu culture. In the southwest corner of Bagmati Province, Chitwan lies between foothills of the Himalaya, the Mahabharat and Siwalik ranges. In the evening, you will enjoy **cultural show** which is known as **Tharu stick dance**.

Day 3 Chitwan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Today you will be escorted by an expert naturalist on various exciting jungle experience including **jeep safari, canoe ride, jungle walk, birdwatching, village walk** and other nature and jungle activities. Jungles at Chitwan National Park are teeming with wild animals like tigers, leopards and rhinos, along the marshes and rivers are gharial and marsh mugger crocodiles basking in the sun. In the evening you can walk around the nearby village to witness daily life of locals.

Day 4 Chitwan – Pokhara (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



This morning be prepared for a long drive to **Pokhara** (6-7hrs), the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Pokhara is famous for breathtaking views of **Mt. Fistail and Annapurna Mountain** ranges and **beautiful lakes**. "Pokhari " means "pond". Pokhara is a variant of Pokhari as the city has numerous ponds. Pokhara is blessed with stunning panoramic views of the Annapurna range which forms its backdrop. free time to explore the lake side area. On arrival in Pokhara, check in to hotel and proceed for **boating in Fewa Lake**. In the evening free time to explore on your own.

Day 5 Pokhara – Phedi – Dhampus (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, be prepared to drive to **Phedi** (1hr) then **trek to Dhampus** (4-5hrs trek). Dhampus is a picturesque village in the Annapurna region. Dhampus hill is short & easy but quite a rewarding trek. A hike to Dhampus will give an opportunity to view amazing mountain ranges and to see and experience the daily lives of the villagers. The trek is best suited for those who wish to experience Nepal stunning mountain scenery and rich ethnic culture in a short time.

Day 6 Dhampus – Sarangkot – Pokhara (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



This morning walk to **Sarangkot** a beautiful and enjoyable walk (4-5hrs) in the middle hills of Nepal that lies near Pokhara, the beautiful lake city. Sarangkot is a hilltop village on the western side of Pokhara with an altitude of 1600m, renowned for its breathtaking sunrise views over mountain ranges. It's a popular destination for adventure enthusiasts and nature lovers seeking serene beauty and unforgettable vistas. Then take a short 30 minutes' drive back to Pokhara.

Day 7

Pokhara – Kathmandu

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast drive back to Kathmandu (8-9hrs) enjoying the natural views along the way. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel and have an easy and perfectly relaxing evening. Kathmandu is a city where ancient traditions are zealously guarded while at the same time embracing modern technology. The grandeur of the past enchants the visitor whose gaze may linger on an exquisitely carved wooden window frame, an 18th century bronze sculpture or a spiritually uplifting stupa.

Day 8

Kathmandu – Nagarkot

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Visit the famous **Kathmandu Durbar Square** – UNESCO World Heritage Site which is one of the major attractions in Kathmandu Valley. The word Durbar Square translated in English as Palace Complex. The Durbar Square, with its old temples and palaces, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the people. Interesting things to see here are **Kumari Ghar (The Living Goddess House)**. At the West end of the square, is a beautiful house full of woodcarving of different God and Goddesses. This Palace is three stories and, in this palace, lives the very famous living, Goddess Kumari. Both Hindus and Buddhists

equally venerate her. For Hindus she is the reincarnation of Hindu Goddess Kali. She is equally worshiped by Buddhists because she is chosen from Buddhist family. This shows the harmony between Buddhist and Hindus in Nepal.

Tours continue with visit to **Great Stupa of Boudhanath** – UNESCO World Heritage Site a vast dome-shaped monument representing the Mind of the Buddha. It is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet

In the afternoon drive to **Nagarkot** (1.5hrs) which is at a height of 2300m above sea level. From this beautiful highland you can catch excellent views of **sunset and sunrise** and **gorgeous mountain ranges** including Mt. Everest on a clear day.

Day 9

Nagarkot – Kathmandu

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Wake up early morning and enjoy the **mesmerizing sunrise** and the **beautiful Himalayan Panoramas** just in front of you. Enjoy the fascinating scenery while enjoying your breakfast. You may wish to have some walk in the village side near your hotel. Then drive back to Kathmandu (1.5hrs) and continue the sightseeing tour.

Proceed for half day sightseeing to the 2000 years old **Swoyambhunath Stupa** – UNESCO World Heritage Site sometimes also known as the “Monkey Temple”. The temple charms with its great

dazzling stupa, while at the same time offers a marvelous view of Kathmandu Valley.

Next destination is **Patan Durbar Square** – UNESCO World Heritage Site. Patan Durbar Square complex is perhaps the most photographed of the three durbar squares. Located in the heart of Patan city, this was once the palace of the kings of Patan. The square is a display of Newari architecture that had reached its pinnacle during the reign of Malla kings who were great builders and patrons of the arts. In the evening proceed for **farewell dinner with cultural show**.

Day 10

Depart from Kathmandu

(Breakfast)

Free & easy. Meet at hotel lobby for departure transfer to Kathmandu airport, bringing home delightful Nepal holiday with Pinnacle Travel.
