Day 1 Arrival in Osaka – Naruto – Takamatsu

(No Meal)

Unique underwater geography

Arrive in Kansai airport, welcome and assist by your friendly tour guide. Proceed to **Naruto Whirlpools** where you can get up close to the whirlpools on a **Sightseeing Boat**. Travel to **Mamehana** and make some traditional **Japanese sweets** using wasanbon sugar, then to **Takamatsu Shopping Street**, where you can stroll along the longest shopping district in Japan.



Day 2 Takamatsu – Kotohira-gu Town – Iya Valley

(Breakfast)

Smell the Gorges

Start your day with a tour to **Konpira-gu Shrine** where you can climb the famous steps to the main shrine and check out the many traditional shops along the way. Try your hand at **making Sanuki Udon**, a Kagawa Prefecture's specialty, at **Nakano Udon School** before heading to **Oboke Gorge** where you will marvel at the beauty of the valley while riding the Oboke Gorge Sightseeing Boat.

Day 3 Iya Valley – Kochi

(Breakfast)

Crossing Vine Bridges

Walk on one of the remaining vine bridges, **Iya-Kazurabashi**, used by samurais of the past. Next, visit **Manneken Pis Statue** (Peeing Boy Statue) and **Ochiai Village** which is one of the remaining old samurai villages. Thereafter, proceed to **Nishijima Horticultural Park** where you can relish in a fun spot of fruit-picking, follow by a visit to **Hirome Market**.



Day 4 Kochi – Shimanto – Uchiko Town – Matsuyama

(Breakfast)

Unwind Your Mind



Tour the beautiful **Kochi Castle**, one of the 12 remaining original castles in Japan, before dropping by **Saltbee** for a **Solar Salt-making Workshop** and **Kuroshio Ichiban** for a traditional **Seared Bonito Straw-grilling Workshop** and meal. Continue tour to **Uchiko Town** where you will find well-preserved merchants' houses from the Edo and Meiji periods. End your day with a visit to **Dogo Onsen**, one of the oldest onsens in Japan, said to have healing properties and frequently visited by the imperial family in the olden days.

Day 5 Matsuyama – Imabari – Kurashiki – Osaka

(Breakfast)

From Historical to Modern Present



Bid farewell to Matsuyama and depart for Osaka. Along the way, stop by **Towel Museum Ichihiro** where you will see how high-quality towels are made and **Kurashiki Bikan Historical Quarter**, a beautifully preserved historic area. Upon arrival, visit **Shinsaibashi-suji Shopping Street**, one of Osaka's internationally famous shopping districts, where you can revel in some retail therapy.



Day 6 Departure from Osaka

(Breakfast)
