Day 1 Arrival in Calgary

(No meal)



Welcome to Calgary

Upon arrival at Calgary airport, our local representative will meet and welcome you. A vibrant and welcoming city situated near the Rocky Mountains in the western province of Alberta, Calgary is ranked as one of the most liveable cities in the world by the Economist Intelligence Unit with top marks in culture, environment and education. Take some time to explore and discover this interesting city at your own leisure.

Day 2 Calgary – Banff

(Breakfast, Lunch)



Scenic Banff National Park with Gondola Ride

Take an adventure through the wondrous **Banff National Park** today. Kick off the tour with a breathtaking ride on the **Banff Sulphur Mountain Gondola** where you will enjoy a 360-degree view of Banff, then explore **Johnston Canyon**, known for its walking trail throughout the year. Stop by **Bow Falls**, **Surprise Corner**, providing a lovely view of the Castle in the Rockies, and **Hoodoos** where you can view interesting rock formations. End the day at **Banff town**.

Day 3 Banff – Jasper

(Breakfast, Lunch)



Extraordinary Jasper National Park with Snocoach Ride

Continue your journey to **Jasper National Park**, the biggest national park in Canada. Drive through **Icefield Parkway**, a vast wilderness of pristine mountain lakes, ancient glaciers and broad sweeping valleys, as you head to **Bow Lake**. Immerse in a one-in-a-lifetime experience as you visit the Canadian Rockies and tour the **Athabasca Glacier** in the **Columbia Icefield Ice Explorer (Snocoach)** and enjoy a breathtaking view of the glacier from **The Glacier Skywalk**. Stop by **Athabasca Falls** before exploring **Jasper Town**, the heart of Jasper National Park.

Day 4 Jasper – Banff

(Breakfast, Lunch)



Memorable Jasper National Park with Cruise Ride

Embark on a relaxing **cruise ride** to enjoy the scenery of **Maligne Lake**, the largest natural lake in the Canadian Rockies. Admire **Maligne Canyon**, carved into the Palliser Formation, a layer of limestone deposited in a shallow tropical sea by lime-secreting plankton about 365 million years ago. Drive by **Medicine Lake** and make stops at **Peyto Lake**, a glacier-fed lake in Banff National Park, **The Crossing** and **Crowfoot Glacier**.

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Day 5 Banff – Calgary

(Breakfast, Lunch)



Unforgettable Banff National Park and Yoho National Park

Set off for **Lake Louise** to admire this beautiful lake named after Princess Louise Caroline Alberta of the United Kingdom. Proceed to **Valley of the Ten Peaks** to visit **Moraine Lake** (replaced by Vermillion Lake if closed), before moving on to **Yoho National Park**. Take a drive through the interesting **Spiral Tunnel** and head to **Emerald Lake**. End the day with a stop at **Natural Bridge**, sculpted by the erosive forces of rushing water over what had once been a waterfall.

Day 6 Calgary – Waterton – Calgary

(Breakfast)



Mesmerising Waterton National Park

Spend the day at **Waterton National Park**, the only park in the world that has three designations – UNESCO World Heritage Site, an International Peace Park and a Biosphere Reserve. Start with a stop at **Prince Wales Hotel**, the park's most recognised landmark, then explore the beautiful **Waterton Town**. Stop by **Cameron Falls** where crystal-clear mountain water cascades over 1.5 billion-year-old Cambrian rock, before proceeding to **Red Rock Canyon** to admire the layers of red and green coloured minerals offering a vivid contrast to each other and the surrounding scenery. Round off the day trip with **Buffalo Paddock** (replaced by Okotoks Big Rock if closed), a specially designated protected area where you will have a chance to observe the largest mammals of the American prairie from a distance.

Day 7 Calgary – Drumheller Valley – Calgary

(Breakfast)



Unique Drumheller Valley

Start the day at **Horseshoe Canyon**, a glacier-carved "U" surrounded by golden prairie, then visit **Royal Tyrrell Museum** with ten galleries devoted to paleontology. View **Little Church** before making a pit stop at **Drumheller Visitor Information Centre**, and marvel at the **Hoodoos of Drumheller**, mushroom-like spires that are internationally recognised icons of the Alberta badlands.

Day 8 Calgary

(No meal)



Vibrant Calgary City

Begin the sightseeing with a walking tour including **New Central Library**, **City Hall** serving as the office for the current Mayor, and **Stephen Avenue**, a major pedestrian mall. Visit **Calgary Tower**, the landmark of the city offering the city's best view. Stop by **Peace Bridge**, a pedestrian bridge that allows both pedestrians and cyclists to cross the Bow River, then pass through **Lion Bridge** at Crescent Heights, enjoying a bird's-eye view of the city of Calgary.

Day 9 Departure from Calgary

(No meal)
