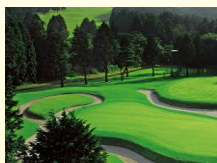

Daihakone Country Club enjoys the rich natural beauty of the Sengoku Highlands, against the backdrop of the mountain ranges along the Hakone Crater. This delightful course features 18 handmade and uniquely landscaped holes. Look out for the 17th Hole par 3, named the 'The Lotus Flower', for its strategic and beautifully landscaped bunkers around the green. Home of the CAT Japan LPGA Tournament in summer.

Fuji Golf Course



Located at the foothills of Mount Fuji, the Fuji Golf Course is one of Japan's most renowned traditional golf courses with its fairways weaving through a dense forest of Japanese Red Pine. The course is fairly flat and wide, allowing for a pleasant round with generous views of the iconic natural attraction.

Strategy and accuracy is key on this course.

Located at 3,000 feet above sea level, the Hakone Yunohana Golf Course boasts spectacular elevated views of the Sagami Bay and Mount Komagatake in the distance. Though fairly flat, the course is an enjoyable test with subtle undulations on the fairways and its bent grass greens.

The Classic Golf Club



Home of the Japan Senior Open 2017, the Classic Golf Club features 3 pristine nines - the King Course, the Queen Course and the Prince Course, each with two greens for play throughout the seasons. Through generally wide, the King Course is flanked by dense forest on either side of its fairways, while more lakes coming into play at the strategic Queen Course. The Prince Course features the most varied layout with doglegged fairways, downhill playing holes and tricky water hazards.

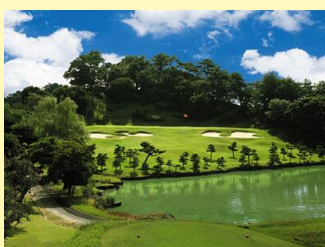
Fukuoka Lake Side Country Club

Although some holes are short, they require strategic play, like the par three 17th with 2 ponds in play.
