Day 1: Arrival to Kota Kinabalu (Breakfast)



Arrive at Kota Kinabalu International Airport, your tour guide or driver will meet and welcome you. Get ready to tee-off in **Sutera Harbour Golf & Country Club**. Part of the Sutera Harbour Resort complex, the Sutera Harbour Golf and Country Club is a 27-hole 6316 meter championship golf course designed by Graham Marsh. Centrally located in the heart of Kota Kinabalu City and just 10 minutes from the International Airport, the course is also within walking distance of both resorts at Sutera Harbour. The Sutera Harbour Golf Club has collected many awards of distinction and hosted several key tournaments including the 2nd Best Golf Resort in 2008 and the Asian Tour 2011 Sabah Masters, respectively. In 2012 Sutera Harbour hosted the One Asia Qualifying School as well a qualifier for the World Amateur Inter-Team Golf Championship, sponsored by Tourism Malaysia that attracts players from all over the world.

After golf, proceed to your hotel and check in for a 3 nights stay.

Day 2: Kota Kinabalu (Breakfast)

This morning, gear up your 2nd golf game in **Sabah Golf & Country Club**. Sabah Golf and Country Club is being rated one of the most challenging Golf Courses in South East Asia. It is designed by Robert Muir Graves and opened for play in 1976. This 18-hole layout was remodeled in 2004 by Nelson & Haworth Golf Course Architects. With a course rating of 73.3 off the back tees, the par-72 18 hole golf course measuring 6,335 meters with hilly terrain, undulating fairways, lakes, hidden sand bunkers and adverse wind conditions offer endless challenges to golfers. Sabah Golf and Country Club have 24 bay driving range and two practice putting greens giving golfers an area to warm up before teeing off. Sabah Golf & Country Club can proudly declare itself to be the State's oldest 18-hole golf course. Though nowhere near as old as the Kudat golf course, which has passed the century mark, the 32 year old golf course presents a golfing experience like no other. Well-known as one of the toughest golf courses in South East Asia, this traditional inland golf course was designed by Robert Muir Graves.



Day 3: Kota Kinabalu (Breakfast)



Enjoy playing your last round of golf in **Kinabalu Golf Club**. The Kinabalu Golf Club or KGC is considered as one of the oldest Clubs in Sabah. It was established several years before the 2nd World War by European employees of the British Chartered Company and the European business establishments in the then British North Borneo. Tee off in style with Mount Kinabalu as your background with the cool crisp air greeting you here at Kinabalu Golf Club. Kinabalu Golf Club is the highest golf layout in Sabah, being situated on Pinosuk Plateau at 1,500 meters above sea level in Kundasang. Designed by Robert Muir Graves, the golf course has a breathtaking scene made up of extensive farmlands and rolling hills.

Day 4: Departure from Kota Kinabalu (Breakfast)

Free till scheduled time, departure transfer to the airport for homebound flight.
