

Day 1: Depart for New Delhi (MOB)

Check in at airport for departure flight to New Delhi

Day 2: Arrive in New Delhi – Check-in Hotel – Old Delhi tour – Jaipur (B/L/D)

Arrive in New Delhi airport, you will be met and transferred to hotel for check-in. Late morning, check-out and begins the tour with visits to unique yet fascinating experience of **Old Delhi**, the capital of Mughal India during 12th and 17th century. Drive past the opulent Red Fort towards the 17th century **Jama Masjid**, one of Asia's largest mosques. Take a private **Tricycle ride** (tour fare includes ride fee) through the lanes of Chandni Chowk, also known as Silver Street. This is perhaps one of Delhi's most populated areas and the largest marketplace. Conclude the tour of Old Delhi with **Raj Ghat**, a memorial to Mahatma Gandhi, father of the nation. After lunch, depart for "**Pink City**" – Jaipur (268km/approx. 5.5 hours).

Day 3: Jaipur Full Day Tour (B/L/D)

After breakfast, board coach to the ancient capital of Amber to see the fabulous **Amber Fort**. Maharaja Mansingh, Mughal Emperor Akbar's most successful General, started the construction of **Amber Fort** in the 17th century. **An elephant (alternatively by jeeps)** will spare you the trouble of reaching up to the fortress. Once on top, stroll through the sprawling complex courtyards and halls. Many of the rooms have delightful wall paintings, with precious stones and mirrors inlaid in the walls. Most fascinating, perhaps, is the **Sheesh Mahal** (Hall of Mirrors) where a single lamplight is reflected in the many mirrors, lighting up the room. En-route to Amber you will stop and see the '**Palace of Winds**', otherwise known as **Hawa Mahal**. It is really an elaborate facade behind which the ladies of the court used to watch the daily goings on in the street below. Next, proceed for sightseeing tour of Jaipur city visit the city of Jaipur. Among the highlights to be seen while touring Jaipur include the **City Palace**, which is an overwhelming complex of exquisite palaces, gardens and courtyards, decorative art and carved doorways. The palace museum houses collections of rare manuscripts, armoury, costumes, carpets and miniature paintings. Walk to the adjacent **Jantar Mantar** or **Astronomical Observatory** made by the Maharaja of Jaipur, built in 1726 and is one of the five such astronomical wonders built by Sawai Jai Singh and makes accurate predictions even to this day. Evening visit Chokhi Dhani for Dinner in Rajasthani style.



Day 4: Jaipur – Agra, Agra Tour (B/L/D)

Following breakfast at the hotel, and depart to Agra (235km/approx. 5hours). Upon arrival visit the **Agra Fort**, an outstanding example of Mughal architecture. Agra Fort - the seat and the stronghold of the Mughal Empire under successive generations. This was the seat of Mughal rule and administration and the present structure owes its origins to Akbar who erected the walls and gates and the first buildings on the eastern banks of Yamuna River. Shah Jehan added the impressive quarters and the mosque while Aurangzeb added the outer ramparts. Visit its Hall of Public Audience and its Royal Pavilions. In the evening, proceed for Sunset tour of the **Taj Mahal** (closed on Fridays). Midway Tonga's "**horse carriages**" would be waiting for you and will drop you at the gates of the Taj Mahal. The Taj Mahal is everything that has been said about it and more. Taking 22 years and 20,000 men to build, the white marble was quarried 200 miles away and was transported to the site by a fleet of 1000 elephants. Built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan as an expression of his love for his wife Mumtaz Mahal, in mid-17th century, the Taj Mahal is truly one of the wonders of the world. Though the Taj appears to be amazingly perfect from almost any angle, it is the close-up marble inlay work, which is really astounding. You will have ample time to view and be mesmerized by this outstanding piece of architecture.



Day 5: Agra – Delhi, New Delhi Tour (B/L/D)

After breakfast, transfer back to New Delhi. Arrive in Delhi, tour to discovery of New Delhi starts with a visit to **Humayun's tomb** ~ the magnificent structure in red sandstone and white marble, one of the finest examples of the garden tomb and a precursor to the Taj Mahal. Visit **Qutab Minar** which is Delhi's Eiffel Tower, its Statue of Liberty and Nelson's Column. Drive to one of the most colonial part of New Delhi called **Raisina Hill**. Drive past the Viceroy's House, now the residence of the President of India and Lutyen's magnum opus; the India Gate, a war memorial arch.

Day 6: Depart from New Delhi (MOB)

Morning, transfer to airport to catch your onward flight. Home Sweet Home!
