### Day 1 Arrival in Dublin (No Meal)

Upon your arrival in Dublin, private transfer from airport to accommodation. Proceed to check-in for 3 nights in Dublin.

### Day 2 Dublin (Breakfast)

Located south of Dublin, **The European Club** is one of the best-rated and toughest links courses in the world. Designed by Pat Ruddy, this challenging par 71 features just two par 5s and three par 3s, with 2 extra optional par 3s. There are lavish views of the Irish Sea from almost every hole, with interesting concealed fairways and interesting swales and dunes that keep golfers thinking. The stunning par four 12<sup>th</sup> Hole plays downhill from an elevated tee box onto a fairway flanking the coastline.



### Day 3 Dublin (Breakfast)

Head to the world-renowned **Portmarnock Golf Club**. Founded in 1894, this traditional links golf course is an absolute treat. Having hosted many notable championships over the years it is widely considered to be one of the fairest links courses in the world. Sitting on narrow strip of dune land alongside a placid estuary, this course challenging with its fast greens and is particularly exposed to the windy elements with its flat and open terrain.



### Day 4 Dublin – Kinsale (Breakfast)

After checking out, take a scenic drive down south to the charming town of Kinsale in Cork. Check into the accommodation at Old Head Golf Links Kinsale for 1 night.

### Day 5 Kinsale – Killarney (Breakfast)

Check out and experience the best of Irish golf down south at the **Old Head Golf Links** in Kinsale. One of the most unforgettable courses you will ever play, the course is perched on a stunning elevated 2-mile strip of Peninsula into the Atlantic Ocean. Enjoy stunning 180-degree vistas of the ocean, with 9 holes played along the cliff's edge. The biggest challenge is the coastal winds that can gain some serious speed. Some shots require a 3 to 4 club adjustment making for a thrilling and breathtaking golfing experience. After the round, we



head west to town of Killarney in scenic region of County Kerry. Check into accommodation in Killarney for 4 nights. Enjoy some free and easy time to sightsee and enjoy the local attractions. Some recommended activities include taking a Jarvey Ride through the National Park (Horse Carriage), visit Muckross Park, or perhaps even a whiskey tasking at the Irish Whiskey Experience.

### Day 6 Killarney

(Breakfast)

18 holes at the **Waterville Golf Links** is a must for any golfer visiting Ireland. The course is carved out of a relatively flat promontory surrounded by placid estuaries, located in the remote southwestern County Kerry region. The par 71 design ensures a memorable variety of challenges like the 16<sup>th</sup> which plays onto a raised narrow green surrounded by thick fescue. The 17<sup>th</sup> is another memorable hole featuring stunning with glorious views of the dune hinterland and coastline from its elevated tee box.



### Day 7 Killarney

(Breakfast)

Play a memorable round at the **Ballybunion Golf Club**, one of the finest seaside golf links experiences. It is the perfect stage to duel with nature with its stunning contoured fairways carved out of undulating dune terrain. Play one of two challenging and unique world-class links golf courses – the Old Course and the Trent Jones Cashen Course. Tom Watson famously said, “Nobody can call himself a golfer until he has played at Ballybunion; you would think the game originated there”.



### Day 8 Killarney

(Breakfast)

Play 18 at the **Tralee Golf Club**, an absolutely delightful Arnold Palmer design. The course is the highlight in any Irish golfing itinerary and the perfect way to end this links golf escapade. Palmer moved very little earth to preserve the characteristic of its natural terrain making for an interesting round on remarkable undulations, troughs and elevations, and exceptional views. Together with the tricky rolling greens and punishing fescue, this course fits the classic Palmer design; beautiful, fun to play and inspires the soul.



### Day 9 Killarney – Dublin

(Breakfast)

Check out. Free and easy sightseeing around Killarney, you may wish to visit Muckross House and Torc Waterfall before transfer back to Dublin.

### Day 10 Departure from Dublin

(Breakfast)

Free till departure transfer from hotel to the airport for your homebound flight. Slan agus Beannacht Leat!
