Day 1 Arrival in Jakarta – Bogor

(No Meal)

Arrive in Jakarta, head south to Bogor and start your arrival game in **Bogor Raya Golf Club**. Elegant, sophisticated and at the same time a rustic place to co-exist with nature. Bogor Raya Club offers ample facilities with modern comfort, yet unquestionably Indonesia in feeling and form. Bogor Raya Golf Club was designed by world renowned Graham V. Marsh, a well-known golf architect from Australia. It was constructed by Pacific Gold (USA) and the landscape by Bensley design group from USA. The 18 holes and 71 par course total land area occupies more than 64 hectares. It is created for those who love a challenging time around the green, yet not too difficult for an average golfer. After golf, check-in to your hotel in Bogor city for 2 nights stay.



Day 2 Bogor

(Breakfast)

Today, enjoy your 2nd round of golf game in Rainbow Hills, destined to take its place among the world's greatest course. **Rainbow Hills Golf Club** is one of Indonesia's finest Golf Courses. The architect of Rainbow Hills, J. Michael Poellot Golf Design Group (JMP) is one of the leading designers for courses across the world. Situated within the majestic highlands of the Bogor Region, this course takes advantage of a picturesque setting by carefully integrating the abundant natural gifts of the site into a spectacular golf landscape.



Day 3 Bogor – Departure from Jakarta

(Breakfast)

Today is all about **Emeralda Golf Club**. The golf course has three separate nine holes, the River Course, Lake Course and Plantation Course. Emeralda Golf Club has played host to several Indonesian Opens, the Johnnie Walker Super Tour, Dunhill Asian Masters and the Volvo Masters Asia. It is designed by Arnold Palmer and Jack Nicklaus. This 27-hole club was designed on a grand scale. The Palmer-designed 18 is nothing but gracious. It is a playable, expertly maintained layout that challenges the visiting player without beating him/her up (provided he plays the appropriate tees). The 6th hole on the River course is a good example — a brawny, striking par-4 that turns right before venturing uphill. It is a tough hole, but there is plenty of room out there and laid out on topography perfectly suited to captivate golfers to continue. After golf, departure transfer to the airport for your homebound flight.
