### Day 1 Arrival in Bangkok

(No Meal)

Upon your arrival in Bangkok airport, our local representative will welcome you and take you by private chauffeur to **The Royal Golf & Country Club**. Its layout features undulating fairways and tiered greens on nearly every hole. The signature hole is the 235-yard hole #17, which is the hardest par 3 hole on the course. Look out for the "Mickey Mouse hole" at the par 4 hole #16, where its sand bunker being shaped like the famous Disney Character, has two imposing ears sticking out. After golf, transfer to your hotel and check-in for 3 nights stay.



### Day 2 Bangkok

(Breakfast)

Get off to an enjoyable day with 18 holes at the beautiful **Cascata Golf Club**. Carved out of rice padi fields, there are 4-nines up for play at this course. The A-Course & B-Course is designed to offer a tropical golfing experience with its open and wide fairways. The C-Course is interesting with the flat terrain transformed into an undulating tropical links style, while the D-Course weaves through beautiful creeks and valleys.



### Day 3 Bangkok

(Breakfast)

Enjoy the **Suwan Golf & Country Club**, a delightful design situated on gentle rolling fairways with beautiful lakes that come into play on almost every hole. With several interesting dogleg holes like par 4, 17<sup>th</sup> strategy and accuracy is key on this challenging course. The course is a worthy championship venue, having hosted professional tournaments like the Asian Tour International and the Thailand Open.



### Day 4 Departure from Bangkok

(Breakfast)

Cap off your Bangkok golfing escapade with a round at **Lam Luk Ka Country Club**. This golfing sanctuary winds its way through Bangkok's wetlands, with a plethora of native trees and wildlife to admire. The club features two 18-hole courses, the championship East Course and the resort West Course. Though enjoyable, the East Course is long and challenging with plenty of water in play, while the West Course is more forgiving with its sweeping fairways. After golf, departure transfer to the airport for your homebound flight.
