### Day 1    Arrival in Phnom Penh    (Lunch, Dinner)



Arrive in Phnom Penh Airport, your chauffeur guide will meet and welcome you and start your day to visit the **Wat Phnom** is on the only 'hill' in town. According to legend, the first pagoda on this site was erected in 1373 to house four statues of Buddha deposited here by the waters of the Mekong River and discovered by Penh, the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles.

Afternoon, visit to the **National Museum** of Cambodia houses one of the world's greatest collections of Khmer cultural material including sculpture, ceramics and ethnographic objects from the prehistoric, pre-Angkorian and post-Angkorian periods, Enjoy **01 hour Sunset Cruise** and the **Sisowath Quay** along the riverfront till dinner at local restaurant. Thereafter transfer to Phnom Penh hotel check in for 3 nights stay.

### Day 2    Phnom Penh    (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, visit to the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) and the **Killing Fields** are a number of sites in Cambodia where collectively more than a million people were killed and buried by the communist Khmer Rouge regime, during its rule of the country from 1975 to 1979, immediately after the end of the Cambodian Civil War (1970–1975). Afternoon, the **Central Market (Phsar Thmei)** in Phnom Penh is one of those busy bazaars that are always filled with effervescent crowd from one end to the other. The Central Market (Phsar Thmei) of Phnom Penh stocks everything right from food items to clothes, silverworks and jewelries, the former **King Norodom Sihanouk** statue and

the **Independence Monument** or **Vimean Ekareach** – as it is referred to in Khmer, is a majestic structure that dominates Phnom Penh city centre. Independence Monument was primarily erected to mark the liberation of the country from the French who ruled Cambodia for almost a century from 1863 to 1953 till dinner at local restaurant.

### Day 3    Phnom Penh    (Breakfast)



After breakfast, overland excursion along the way to **Ou Dong Mountain** stopover in **Phnom Praset**, visit the Pre-Angkor temple (8thc.) And the pagoda to view the reclining Buddha. Enjoy the beautiful view of the surrounding plains and rice-fields from the hilltop temple. Continue driving to Ou Dong where enjoy picnic lunch on your own orders and expenses. Afternoon visit the various temples and the three large stupas where the ashes of three former kings are preserved. Next visit the Vihara of 18 Cubit Buddha, end of tour return to Phnom Penh city.

### Day 4    Departure from Phnom Penh    (Breakfast)

Free at own leisure till departure transfer to Phnom Penh airport for homebound flight.
