Day 1 Arrival in Jeju

(No Meal)

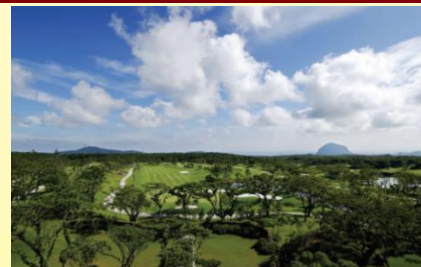
Arrive in Jeju airport, meet and welcome for private transfer to **Elysian Jeju Country Club**. This prestigious golf course is well-loved by golf aficionados. Located 500m above sea level, the course plays through lush forests and showcases scenic vistas of Jeju Island with views of Hallasan Mountain in the distance. Though relatively flat, the waterways and strategic bunkering make this an enjoyable experience. Elysian Jeju is famous for its eco-friendly golf course, at times you may see wild animals such as roe deer, pheasant, and crane on the course. After golf, transfer to your hotel and check-in for 4 nights stay.



Day 2 Jeju

(Breakfast)

Breathe with nature for a round of golf at **Teddy Valley Golf & Resort**, an 18-hole par 72 golf course designed by architect Kim Hak-Young. This spectacular course plays at 7,259 yards with 6 tee boxes, featuring challenging bunkers, numerous water features such as ponds and creeks, and palm trees. It is often regarded as one of the most scenic golf courses in the whole of Jeju, offering sweeping mountain views of Hallasan Mountain and Sanbangsan Mountain, and nearby islands such as Hyeongjeseom Island, Gapado Island and Marado Island.



Day 3 Jeju

(Breakfast)

Be excited to play 18 holes at the stunning **Raon Golf Club**. This golf course was designed by Colin Montgomerie. Situated on the north side of Mount Halla, there are three courses at Raon, the Stone Course, Lake Course and Pine Course nestled in breathtaking views of Hallasan Mountain, the surrounding volcanic hills and the blue ocean. The 2nd hole of Stone Course became famous when Tiger Woods played for a skins game in an exhibition tournament on 14th November 2004. It is intimidating if you hit a tee shot with greed to hit it far and the approach shot for attacking the green required precision.



Day 4 Jeju

(Breakfast)

Cap off your Jeju golf tour with a round at the magnificent **Jungmun Beach Golf Club**. One of the few seaside courses in Jeju, the course is a must-play with stunning vistas of neighbouring coastal cliffs and valleys. The club shot to fame when it hosted a PGA Tour event the Johnnie Walker Championship back in 1995. With a fairly long course setup, the undulations coupled with the coastal winds make for a challenging but fun round



Day 5 Departure from Jeju

(Breakfast)

Free till departure transfer from hotel to the airport for your onward flight.

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
