Day 1 Arrival in Phnom Penh (Lunch, Dinner)



Arrive in Phnom Penh Airport, your chauffeur guide will meet and welcome you. Your first tour stop in Phnom Penh will be the **Wat Phnom** is on the only 'hill' in town, according to legend the first pagoda on this site was erected in 1373 to house four statues of Buddha deposited here by the waters of the Mekong River and discovered by Penh, the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles. Afternoon, visit to the **National Museum** of Cambodia houses one of the world's greatest collections of Khmer cultural material including sculpture, ceramics and ethnographic objects from the prehistoric, pre-Angkorian, Angkorian and post-Angkorian periods, Enjoy **01 hour Sunset Cruise** and the **Sisowath Quay** along the riverfront till dinner at local restaurant, afterwards check in Phnom Penh hotel for 2 nights stay.

Day 2 Phnom Penh (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, visit to the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) and the **Killing Fields** are a number of sites in Cambodia where collectively more than a million people were killed and buried by the communist Khmer Rouge regime, during its rule of the country from 1975 to 1979, immediately after the end of the Cambodian Civil War (1970–1975). Afternoon, the **Central Market (Phsar Thmei)** in Phnom Penh is one of those busy bazaars that are always filled with effervescent crowd from one end to the other. The Central Market (Phsar Thmei) of Phnom Penh stocks everything right from food items to clothes, silverworks and jewelries, the former **King Norodom Sihanouk** statue and the **Independence Monument** or **Vimean Ekareach** – as it is referred to in Khmer, is a majestic structure that dominates Phnom Penh city centre. Independence Monument was primarily erected to mark the liberation of the country from the French who ruled Cambodia for almost a century from 1863 to 1953 till dinner at local restaurant.

Day 3 Phnom Penh – Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, board a public air-conditioned bus to Siem Reap (Approx.5-6hours). On arrival, our guide will pick you up and transfer to have your welcome lunch. Late afternoon tour visits to **Angkor Silk Farm** and our guides will give you more details on the mulberry trees, silkworm farming, cocoon unwinding, preparation of the silk threads, ikat technique (tie-dyeing of the threads) and silk weaving. Next, visit to **Les Artisans d'Angkor - Chantiers Ecole** where visitors can observe students learning traditional carving and finishing techniques till dinner with **Apsara Dance Show** at local restaurant. Thereafter transfer back Siem Reap hotel for 2 nights stay.

Day 4 Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Today you will embark on a tour to discover the spectacular Angkor Thom and Angkor Wat regions, Start the day with a visit to the **Angkor Thom Temple South Gate**. Inside the walls of this city, you will tour to **Bayon Temple** standing in the exact center of the city of Angkor Thom. Located 200m northwest of the Bayon is the **Baphuon Temple**, a single sanctuary temple-mountain situated on a high base. Then, visit the **Phimean Akas Temple**, built of roughly hewn sandstone blocks and has little decoration. Next visit to **Elephants Terrace**, dedicated to Buddhist and replica to the Bayon style of art. Afterwards head to **Leper King Terrace** faced with dramatic bas-reliefs and carries on the grandeur theme that characterizes the building during Jayavaram VII's region. You will also tour to **Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond**, enclosed by a laterite wall with only the base remaining today. Thereafter proceed visit to **Ta-Prom Temple**, built in the bayon style from late 12th to early 13th century, the photogenic and atmospheric combination of trees growing out of the ruins and the jungle surrounding have made the UNESCO World Heritage Site one of Angkor's most visited temples. After lunch, continue our journey to **Angkor Wat Temple** – one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world, built in between the 9th – 13th century, Last day of your make a visit to **Phnom Bakheng** for its **Beautiful Sunset**.

Day 5 Departure from Siem Reap (Breakfast)

After breakfast, free at own leisure till departure transfer to Siem Reap airport for homebound flight.
