Day 1 Arrival in Siem Reap (Lunch, Dinner)



Arrive in Siem Reap Airport, your chauffeur guide will meet and welcome you, proceed tour to visit **Angkor Silk Farm** and tour guide will give you more details on the mulberry trees, silkworm farming, cocoon unwinding, preparation of the silk threads, ikat technique (tie-dyeing of the threads) and silk weaving, the **Khmer Ceramics Centre** located on the road to the temples, this ceramics center is dedicated to reviving the Khmer tradition of pottery, which was an intricate art during the time of Angkor and **Les Artisans d'Angkor - Chantiers Ecole** where visitors can observe students learning traditional carving and finishing techniques till dinner with **Apsara Dance Show** at local restaurant. End of the day transfer to Siem Reap hotel check in for 3 nights stay.

Day 2 Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Today tour visit to Angkor Thom Area via **Angkor Thom Temple South Gate** inside the walls of this city, you will tour to **Bayon** is the exact center of the city of Angkor Thom and located 200m northwest of the Bayon is the **Baphuon**, a single sanctuary temple-mountain situated on a high-base. Continue to **Phimean Akas Temple** built of roughly hewn sandstone blocks and has little decoration. Next to **Elephants Terrace** dedicated Buddhist and replica to the Bayon style of art. Afterwards head to the **Leper King Terrace** faced with dramatic bas-relief and carries on the grandeur theme that characterizes the building during Jayavarm VII's region. You will also tour to **Royal Palace, Woman and Man Pond**. Following visit the **Ta-Prom Temple** surrounding have made UNESCO World Heritage Site one of Angkor most visit temple. After lunch, continue our journey to **Angkor Wat Temple** one of the seven greatest architectural wonders of the world built in between the 9th – 13th century. Lastly make a visit to **Phnom Bakheng** to view **Beautiful sunset**.

Day 3 Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, we visit the **Floating Village** of **Chong Khneas**. Chong Khneas is the name of famous floating village at the edge of the lake. It locates at Southern part of Siem Reap town about 15 Km and takes only 30 minutes by vehicles to the boat dock where there are always boats waiting for visitors. You will explore the different of Khmer, Muslim and Vietnamese floating households and the floating markets, fisheries, clinics, schools, basketball court, pigsty and other boatloads of tourists and the **Cambodian Cultural Village** where is designed to provide tourists with an excellent insight into the life and culture of the Cambodians; their traditions and practices, etc.

Day 4 Siem Reap – Phnom Penh (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



This morning board a public air-conditioned bus to Phnom Penh (Approximately 5 - 6 hours). On arrival, meet and welcomed by local tour guide, enjoy your welcome lunch at local restaurant. Afterwards proceed tour to visit **Wat Phnom** is on the only 'hill' in town and according to legend, the first pagoda on this site was erected in 1373 to house four statues of Buddha deposited here by the waters of the Mekong River and discovered by Penh, the former **King Norodom Sihanouk statue** and the **Independence Monument** or **Vimean Ekareach** – as it is referred to in Khmer, is a majestic structure that dominates Phnom Penh city center. Independence Monument was primarily erected to mark the liberation of the country from the French who ruled Cambodia for almost a century from 1863 to 1953 till dinner at local restaurant. Afterwards transfer to Phnom Penh hotel check in for 2 nights stay.

Day 5 Phnom Penh (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, visit the **Royal Palace**, built by King Norodom in 1866 on the site of the old town, and the **Silver Pagoda**. Located within the grounds of the Royal Palace, the Silver Pagoda is so named because of its floor, which is made up of 5000 silver tiles and the **National Museum** of Cambodia houses one of the world's greatest collections of Khmer cultural material including sculpture, ceramics and ethnographic objects from the prehistoric, pre-Angkorian, Angkorian and post-Angkorian periods. Continue to the Notorious **Tuol Sleng Museum**, In 1975 Tuol Svay Prey High School was taken over by Pol Pot's security forces and turned into a prison known as Security Prison 21 (S-21) and the **Central Market (Phsar Thmei)** in Phnom Penh is one of those busy bazaars that are always filled with effervescent crowd from one end to the other. The Central Market (Phsar Thmei) of Phnom Penh stocks everything right from food items to clothes, silverworks and jewelries until dinner at local restaurant.

Day 6 Departure from Phnom Penh (Breakfast)

Free at own leisure till departure transfer to Phnom Penh airport for homebound flight.
