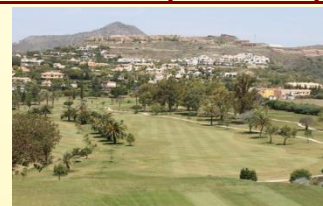


### Day 1 Arrival in Malaga – Marbella (No Meal)

On arrival in Malaga airport, your chauffeur will meet and welcome you. Proceed to your hotel in Marbella where you will check-in for 6 nights stay.

### Day 2 Marbella (Breakfast)

Play a round at the **El Paraiso Golf Club**, a Gary Player design and one of the most established clubs on the Costa del Sol. Located in the El Paraiso valley, this relatively flat course enjoys stunning views of the majestic La Concha Mountain in the distance. Good club selection and a deft touch around the greens is key. A challenging but fair course.



### Day 3 Marbella (Breakfast)



Play 18 holes at **La Quinta Golf & Country Club**, which previously hosted the Spanish Ladies Open. There are 3 scenic nines located in the Benahavis Golf Valley surrounded by mountains. The San Pedro 'A' Course is fairly open with wide fairways, while the Ronda 'B' Course has narrow fairways and strategically placed greens. The Gaudaiza 'C' Course is the longest nine, with doglegged holes and interesting elevation changes.

### Day 4 Marbella (Breakfast)

The 3<sup>rd</sup> round of golf will be played at **Los Naranjos Golf Club**. This Robert Trent Jones Sr. design, has hosted major international competitions such as the World Cup and the Spanish PGA Championship. The course is challenging with its generous fairways and large undulating greens punctuated by strategically placed bunkers and water hazards ready to catch errant shots.



### Day 5 Marbella (Breakfast)



Play at **Marbella Golf Country Club**, one of the most challenging golfing experiences on Costa Del Sol. This Robert Trent Jones Sr design is unique with many dramatic elevated and downhill shots on its hilly terrain. The excellent bunkering and undulating greens, together with well-placed hazards make for a memorable round. On a clear day, golfers might even catch a glimpse of Gibraltar.

### Day 6 Marbella (Breakfast)

The final round will be played at the **Atalaya Golf & Country Club**. Set against the stunning backdrop of the Sierra Blanca mountains, the 'New Course' is fairly straightforward, with five par 3s and five par 5s in play. The narrow and gently undulating fairways, together with the large and fast greens make this course interesting.



### Day 7 Marbella – Departure from Malaga (Breakfast)

Free till departure transfer from hotel to the airport for your homebound flight.
