Day 1 Arrival in Nagoya – Mie

(No Meal)

Arrive in Nagoya airport, meet and transfer to Shima Region, on arrival check-in hotel for a 3 nights' stay.

Day 2 Mie (Breakfast)

Step on the first tee box at the seaside course **Nemu Golf Club**. Embraced by the seas and woodlands of Shima, Nemu Golf Club is one of Japan's foremost world-class stay-and-play golf resorts. It offers an 18-hole golf course that recently underwent a major remodelling in 2015. Overlooking Ago Bay with breathtaking views, the course is a wonderful mix of seaside splendour and woodland retreat. This new layout which measures 6,768 yards offer lush green fairways that set against the blue skies create an impressive backdrop. Native trees meander their way through the natural terrain give each hole an even more distinctive look.



The beautiful white-sand bunkers on the course adds another level of excitement. In addition, the ever-changing sea breezes will keep all golfers on their toes.

Day 3 Mie (Breakfast)

Bring more golf balls when you golf at the challenging **Ise Country Club**. Tough layout, narrow tree lines fairways set out on gently undulating terrain in Tamaki, Mie. It was the first Japanese course to use two greens per hole, which is still favoured by many clubs today. Ranked 19th in Japan, the course is a good test of both mental and physical skill. It requires the use of intelligent shot making and strategy at times. The course is challenging with narrow fairways lined by trees and well-placed bunkers. Water comes into play occasionally, most notably at three of the four par 3 holes. There are several notable holes on the course,



including the right doglegged par 4 hole #2, the left doglegged hole #6 and the par 3 hole #9, which plays across an irrigation pond to the peninsula greens complex.

Day 4 Mie (Breakfast)

Hotel check-out. Gear up for a round at **Excellent Golf Club Ise Otori Course**, which become famous for the golf match between Tiger Woods and Hideki Maruyama. Located in Tsu City, this magnificent 18-hole golf course is opened for play on 27th August 1998, has a choice of four tee positions with the back tees playing to 7,074 yards. Aside from the hilly terrain throughout, the course features wide fairways, undulating greens and beautifully maintained bunkers, which awaits the challenge of golfers. Water is dominant in the layout. Two additional ponds come into play on five holes as these holes involve shots over



water requiring accuracy and adequate judgement. Among the signature holes on the course is hole #9, a long and difficult par 4, which requires careful approach shots due to the green's floating islands. After golf, proceed to your hotel in Central Region for remaining 3 nights' stay.

Day 5 Mie (Breakfast)

Be excited for a game at Mie's flagship course **Tsu Country Club**. In the rolling hills of Tsu City, enjoy playing in the best conditions at this championship course anytime of the year. With a length of over 7,023 yards, this stunning course will test both your mental and physical skills. Tsu Country Club provides a perfect balance of beauty and strategy, with bent one greens, large decorative white sand bunkers and a large pond surrounded by bricks motivates players to take on challenges. Fairways sweep majestically between the trees, bunkers and water hazards and are maintained to the highest of standards. The hilly terrain provides plenty of elevation changes to keep you on your toes



Day 6 Mie (Breakfast)

Morning play 18 holes golf at the **Chunichi Country Club**, a 27-hole par 108 golf course located in Suzuka City. It was opened for play in 1979 and offers spectacular views of the magnificent Suzuka mountain range. Designed by the renowned architects Seizo Tomizawa and Hirochika Tomizawa, the course has been divided into three sets of 9 holes, namely West Course, Middle Course and East Course. The terrain is relatively flat, but the trees and forest which surround the golf course made strategic test for players of all abilities. It has a dual green system with Bentgrass and the fairways are Korai grass. At Chunichi Country



Club, you can combine two different sets of nine holes to create a new round of golf, which makes it a great experience

Day 7 Mie – Departure from Nagoya

(Breakfast)

Wrap up memorable Mie golf holiday with final round at the beautiful **Mie Country Club**. Opened in 1960, it is one of the oldest clubs features a relaxed layout that takes advantage of the flat terrain at the foot of Mount Gozaisho, in Komono. A few elevation changes across the 18-hole course provides some wonderful vistas. Water is not abundant, but bunkers are well-positioned, creating a few difficult shot selections. Each hole has a relatively wide fairway, making it ideal for beginners too. The signature hole #12 is well-known for its optical illusion created by the designer Yoten Yasuda, earning its reputation of



the "Impregnable Green". After golf, departure transfer to Nagoya airport for your homebound flight.
