Day 1 Arrival in Cape Town

(No Meal)

Welcome to Cape Town

Arrive in Cape Town airport, welcome and assist by our local representative for your transfer to hotel.

Day 2 Cape Town

(Breakfast)

Captivating Cape Town Tour



This morning, you will go on a half day sightseeing tour of Cape Town including a visit to the famous Table Mountain, a UNESCO World Heritage site. Begin your day with a **Cable Car Ride** to the peak of **Table Mountain**, a must-see attraction for all visitors to Cape Town. The Table Mountain cableway boasts revolving floors, giving passengers a 360-degree panoramic view of the surroundings. From the summit of Table Mountain on a clear day, you are rewarded with spectacular views of the city, its Waterfront, Camps Bay, the majestic Hottentots

Holland Mountains to the East and the mountains of the Cape Peninsula all the way down to Cape Point to the south. Take your time and enjoy this unique scenery, go for a walk or have a bite at the restaurant while admiring the great view. After descending the mountain, you will depart on a tour of the "Mother City" taking in **Signal Hill** – where the Noon Gun is fired at mid-day (daily except Sundays and public holidays) – through the colourful **Bo-Kaap** or **Cape Malay Quarter**, past the **Grand Parade**, **City Hall** and the **Castle of Good Hope** and **South African Cultural History Museum**.



Day 3 Cape Town

(Breakfast)

Charming Cape Point Tour



Today, you will embark on a **Full-day Cape Peninsula Tour**. Enjoy a scenic drive along the picturesque Atlantic coastline from Cape Town to Cape Point, passing by the fishing village of **Hout Bay**, travel along **Chapman's Peak Drive**, proceed through the picturesque **Noordhoek Beach**, before arriving at **Cape Point Nature Reserve**. Cape Point is popularly referred to as the mythical meeting point of the Atlantic and Indian Ocean. Walk up or take the funicular to the **Old Lighthouse** to enjoy breathtaking views of the two oceans and surrounding coastline. You will also see the **New**

Lighthouse that was built in 1911. It remains one of the most powerful lighthouses on the South African coast, with a range of 60 kilometres and a luminous intensity of 10 million candelas. Continue tour to **Boulders Beach in Simon's Town** to see the endangered **African Penguin Colony** in their natural habitat. Drive pass **Kalk Bay** on your return route and make a last stop at the **Kirstenbosch National Botanical Garden**, situated at the eastern slopes of Table Mountain, is acclaimed as one of the great botanic gardens of the world. The 528 hectares estate includes a cultivated garden and a nature reserve. It was designated a UNESCO World Heritage in 2004.

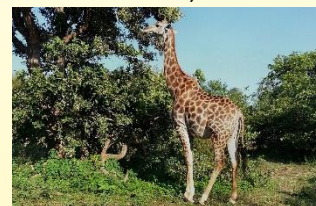

Day 4 Cape Town – Hoedspruit or Skukuza – Kruger National Park (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Kruger Park Safari Tour



Get ready to be transferred to Cape Town airport for your domestic flight to Hoedspruit (or Skukuza). Upon arrival, meet and transfer to the lodge in **Kruger National Park**, home to a plethora of animal species, from plains game like zebra and antelope to the magnificent Big 5 – namely African buffalo, elephant, leopard, lion and rhino. The park is a bird watcher's paradise and is sure to thrill and intrigue you. After lunch and some relaxation time, head out on your first **Afternoon Safari Game Drive** to explore the beautiful landscapes and wildlife. Journey through the bush, spotting endangered white rhino, tall giraffe feeding in thorn thickets and herds of buffalo coming down to drink at waterholes. After the drive, return to the lodge for a delicious dinner. Fall asleep to the gentle sounds of the African bush at night.



Day 5 Kruger National Park (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Africa's Big Five Game Drive



An exciting day awaits you today, so you will be up early and get ready for the **Game Drive** just after the sun comes up. Watch as the African bush comes to life with the beginning of a new day and smell the fresh clean air of the morning. Discover the diverse wildlife of the park, including herds of impala, kudu and zebra. Your guide will help you spot and identify the many species of birds in the park such as the majestic tawny or martial eagles. After the drive, return to the lodge for a tasty breakfast. Spend a few hours at your leisure to relax and enjoy real Africa in the wilderness, and then it is time for another exciting **Game Drive**. Continue to discover this diverse region, spotting everything from a mongoose to herds of elephant and seek out the prowling predators. Return to the lodge in the evening and savour a delicious meal. Listen to the sounds of the African night - the call of a Leopard or the roar of a Lion in the distance.



Day 6 Kruger National Park (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Spectacular African Wildlife



The smell of fresh coffee indicates the start of a new day. Delve deeper into the scenic bush of the Kruger National Park on a **Morning Game Drive**. See how the guide follows the tracks of lion or hyena. Listen as the birds start calling and smell the fresh scent of the bush. Explore this complex region and see everything from small creatures such as dung beetles and chameleons, to herds of elephant or an endangered white rhino. Return to the lodge for breakfast and enjoy a few hours at your leisure. You will then set off on an **Afternoon Game Drive**. Continue to discover the abundant wildlife of the region. In the evening, drive back to the lodge with time to freshen up before enjoying a sumptuous dinner.



Day 7 Kruger National Park – Departure from Hoedspruit or Skukuza (Breakfast)
