Day 1 Arrival in Delhi (No Meal)

Welcome to Delhi

Arrive in New Delhi airport, welcome and assist by our local representative for your transfer to the hotel in Delhi.

Day 2 Delhi – Jodhpur (Breakfast)

By Flight To The Blue City



Start your day with a visit to **Qutab Minar**, a 73-metre-high minaret built in 1193. It is the tallest brick minaret in the world and a UNESCO World Heritage site. At the foot of the tower is the Quwwat-ul-Islam Mosque, the first mosque to be built in India. A 7m high iron pillar stands in the courtyard of the mosque. It is said that if you can encircle it with your hands while standing with your back to it, your wish will be fulfilled. Thereafter, transfer to airport for your domestic **flight to Jodhpur**, the second largest city in Rajasthan, popularly known as the "**Blue City**". Upon arrival, meet and proceed for a tour of Jodhpur. Visit the famous **Mehrangarh Fort**, the most magnificent fort in Jodhpur, situated on a 150m high hill. It was built by Rao Jodha, the former chief of Rathore clan, in 1459. Standing sentinel to the city

below, it overlooks the rugged and rocky terrain and houses a palace intricately adorned with long carved panels and latticed windows, exquisitely wrought from red sandstone. Continue tour to the **Jaswant Thada**, a beautiful marble memorial located adjacent to Mehrangarh Fort. It was built by

Maharaja Sardar Singh of Jodhpur State in 1899 in memory of his father, Maharaja Jaswant Singh II, and serves as the cremation ground for the royal Rajput family of Marwar. Thereafter, transfer to the hotel for check-in.

Day 3 Jodhpur – Jaipur (Breakfast)

Roadway To The Pink City

After breakfast, sit back and relax on the long drive to Jaipur, the capital of India's Rajasthan state. Jaipur is also known as the "Pink City" due the color of its buildings. Built by Maharaja Sawai Jai Singh II in 1727 CE, the city's plan followed a grid system, making it the only planned city of its time. Vidhyadhar Bhattacharya, a young Bengali architect, designed it as per the texts of the Shilp Shastra, an ancient Indian treatise on architecture.



Day 4 Jaipur (Breakfast)

Explore The Beauty of Jaipur



Today, you will enjoy a sightseeing tour of Jaipur, which starts with a photo stop at **Hawa Mahal**, also known as "**Palace of Breeze**". It is the most well-known landmark of Jaipur city, built by Sawai Pratap Singh in 1799. This five-storey building overlooking the busy street is a fascinating example of Rajput architecture. It has 953 windows on the outside walls. The honeycomb shaped and beautifully carved windows allow breeze to blow through the palace and makes it a perfect summer palace. The construction of Hawa Mahal allows the royal ladies to observe everyday life and festivals celebrated

in the street below without being seen, as they had to obey the strict rules of "purdah". Continue tour to **Amber Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage site that sits atop a picturesque and rugged hill. This magnificent fort is an extensive palace complex that has been built with pale yellow and pink sandstone, and with white marble. Enjoy a wonderful **Elephant Ride** up to Amber Fort like the royalty of Rajasthan used to do. Next, visit the **City Palace of Jaipur** and the UNESCO-listed **Jantar Mantar**, an astronomical observation site constructed between 1724 and 1730.

Day 5 Jaipur – Agra (Breakfast)

Tour Seven Wonders Of The World



This morning, you will head to Agra, an ancient city once the capital of the Mughal empire in the 16th and 17th century. On arrival, proceed to visit the world-famous **Taj Mahal**, one of the **Seven Wonders of the World**, an essential sight for all visitors to India. Standing majestically on the banks of Yamuna

River, Taj Mahal is a monument of immeasurable beauty and a magnificent symbol of enduring love. This stunning white marble mausoleum was built in the 17th century by Emperor Shah Jahan in

memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal. It took approximately 22 years and an estimated 20,000 workers to build this masterpiece that reflects different colours under the canopy of sun. The purity of the white marble, the exquisite ornamentation, precious gemstones used and its picturesque location, make Taj Mahal ranks among the most popular tourist attractions in the world. Note: Taj Mahal is



closed on Fridays. Thereafter, you will visit the red sandstone **Agra Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage site with its incredible maze of courtyards, mosques and lavish private chambers reflecting the grandeur of the Mughal Empire. Your evening is free to explore at leisure.

Day 6 Agra – Delhi (Breakfast)

Heartbeat City Tour Of Delhi



Bid farewell to Agra and make your way back to New Delhi. Upon arrival, you will proceed for a half day sightseeing tour of Delhi, which begins with a visit to the UNESCO World Heritage site, **Humayun's Tomb**. This magnificent garden tomb is the first substantial example of Mughal architecture in India, built in 1565. Next, you will drive past the **Parliament House** and the **Rashtrapati Bhavan** (once the Viceroy's



residence), now the official residence of the President of India, and make photo stop at **India Gate**, a war memorial located astride the Rajpath, built to commemorate the Indian soldiers who sacrificed their lives for the country during World War I. After the tour, transfer to the hotel. Evening at leisure.
