Today, you will embark on a tour to **Sergiev Posad**, one of the oldest cities of Russia. It is home to the **Trinity Lavra of St. Sergius**, the most important Russian monastery and is a world famous spiritual centre of the Russian Orthodox Church. The monastery was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 1993. The town also claims to be the birthplace of the Russian nesting doll or matryoshka. During the tour, you will see other fascinating **Monasteries** and **Museums**.


Day 3 Moscow (Breakfast, Lunch)

The Symbol of Russia





Start your day with a tour to **Moscow Kremlin**, the iconic landmark in Russia, a beautiful fortress in the heart of Moscow. It serves as the official residence of the Russian Federation president. Discover the unique monuments of architecture and art of the 15th to 20th centuries, which consist of churches and chambers, majestic palaces and ceremonial administrative buildings. Walk along the **Kremlin Squares and Streets**, see the **Tsar Bell and Tsar Cannon**, as well as visit the **Assumption Cathedral**, the oldest church in Kremlin, built of white stone in 1475–1479 in the Italianate-Byzantine style. Moscow Kremlin has been included in the UNESCO World Heritage list in 1990. Next, take a walk down the **Stary**



Arbat, one of the oldest surviving streets in Moscow, famous for its architectural masterpieces and souvenirs. Performances of talented street artists with clowns, singers and dancers give a special charm to this street. You will later go on a fascinating **Moscow Metro Tour** to explore the most

beautiful metro stations in the world. Marvel at the exquisite interiors of these stations and be impressed by the underground palaces of Moscow.

Day 5 St Petersburg (Breakfast)

Discover Famous Attractions of St. Petersburg







Enjoy a morning sightseeing tour of St. Petersburg, where you will be taken through the main streets and squares of the city - Nevsky Prospect, Palace Square, Vasilyevsky Island Spit, Mars Field, Fontanka River Embankment and more. You will visit St. Isaac's Cathedral, one of the largest church buildings in the world, built in honor of the patron saint of Peter I himself - Isaac of Dalmatia. The cathedral was erected by the famous French architect - Auguste Montferrand. During the construction of the cathedral, many technical innovations were applied, which made it possible to create such grandeur and luxury of both facades and interiors. Today Isaakievsky is recognized as one of the outstanding examples of Russian religious buildings with amazing luxurious decoration. In its interiors, you can count over 150 works of monumental painting of the mid-19th century. Stained glass windows, mosaics, sculptures and a spectacular combination of colored stone and gilding create a rich color spectrum that leaves an indelible impression on everyone who has visited this richest Museum at least once. Following next, visit Peter and Paul Fortress, the oldest architectural monument of St. Petersburg. The date of the foundation stone of the fortress, May 16, 1703, is the date of the founding of St. Petersburg. The modern Peter and Paul Fortress houses numerous architectural monuments and museums. The fortress belongs to the historical part of St. Petersburg and together with the complex of monuments located here, they are included in the list of UNESCO World Heritage sites. The silhouette of the Peter and Paul Fortress has become a symbol of the city and occupies a key place in its panorama. Thereafter, enjoy a romantic Boat Cruise along Neva River

and marvel at the panoramic view of St. Petersburg embankments and architecture.

Day 6 St Petersburg (Breakfast, Lunch)

The Amazing Peterhof Palace



This morning, get yourself ready to depart for **Peterhof** to explore the **Grand Palace**, **Grand Fountain Cascade** and **Lower Park**. Visit the Grand Palace and be amazed with its fascinating and elaborate interiors. This world-famous palace, fountain and park ensemble of Peterhof shines forth as a glittering landmark of Russia's aesthetic culture in the 18th and 19th centuries. Its wonderful parks, 176 fountains of various forms, majestic palaces, numerous gilded statues of

ancient gods and heroes, paintings, works of art and culture, make Peterhof a veritable gem of art. It is often called the "Capital of Fountains", which is unique in the world. The palace-ensemble along with the city center is recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site.



Day 7 Departure from St Petersburg

(Breakfast)

St Petersburg Hermitage Tour



In the morning, you will proceed to the **Hermitage Museum** to see the interiors of the **Winter Palace** (UNESCO) and arts collection in the main building. The museum is located in five main

buildings on the Palace Embankment, interconnected and forming a single museum complex. One of the buildings of the Hermitage is the Winter Palace, which in the past was the main imperial palace, the current building of which was built in 1754-1762. The Hermitage is one



of the largest art museums in the world. It began as a personal collection of Empress Catherine II and now the collection numbers over 3.5 million items. Among them are the masterpieces of

Leonardo da Vinci, Rembrandt, antique sculpture, Egyptian antiquities, a real mummy and much more. Transfer to railway station or St. Petersburg airport for homebound flight.
