Day 1 Arrival in Delhi

(No Meal)

Welcome to Delhi

Arrive in New Delhi airport, welcome and assist by our local representative for your transfer to the hotel.



Day 2 Delhi – Srinagar

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Houseboat Floating Accommodation Experience



In the morning, transfer to New Delhi airport for your domestic **flight to Srinagar**. Located in the heart of the Kashmir Valley, which is called “Paradise on Earth”, Srinagar’s landscape is interspersed with greenery, lakes and hillocks. The city is spread out along the banks of the Jhelum River and is famous for its surrounding natural beauty. Upon arrival, meet and transfer to the **Houseboat**, your floating accommodation for tonight. You will later proceed for a city tour of Srinagar, visiting the beautiful **Mughal Gardens** located on the banks of the famous Dal Lake. The terrace gardens of **Nishat**

Bagh (Garden of Pleasure) built in 1633 and **Shalimar Bagh** (Garden of Love) built by Emperor Jehangir for his wife Nur Jehan, offer magnificent views of mountain range and breathtaking views of Dal Lake. Evening at leisure.

Day 3 Srinagar – Gulmarg – Srinagar

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Explore the Nature Wonderland of Gulmarg



This morning, embark on an excursion to **Gulmarg**, also referred to as the “Meadow of Flowers”, situated at an altitude of 2650m above sea level. This hill town is one of the most beautiful summer resorts in the valley, a haven for adventure seekers and a paradise for nature lovers. Gulmarg is also popular for its golf course in summer and skiing during winter. The journey to Gulmarg is half the

enchantment of reaching there. Roads bordered by rigid avenues of poplar give over to flat expanses of rice fields interspersed with picturesque villages. Depending on the season, nature's colors could be the translucent green of spring, summers rich emerald, or autumn’s golden hues, when scarlet chilies festoon windows of village homes. Take a leisure walk on the lush green meadows of flowers with backdrop of the snowcapped mountains and enjoy a **Gondola Cable Car Ride** (first phase only). In the afternoon, return to Srinagar. Evening, you will enjoy a relaxing **Shikara Boat Ride** along the scenic Dal Lake and witness the beauty of this city, which is often compared to Venice. You will get a view of some very interesting places around the lake.



Day 4 Srinagar – Pahalgam – Srinagar

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Discover The Beautiful Pahalgam



Today, you will proceed for a day trip to **Pahalgam**, also known as the “Valley of Shepherds” or “Trekker’s Paradise”. Located on the banks of Lidder River at an altitude of 2130m, surrounded by thickly wooded pine forests, breathtaking vistas of meadows and the snow-clad Himalayan mountains, Pahalgam is a famous hill station in Jammu and Kashmir where many films have been shot. The town of Pahalgam offers breathtaking scenery and is one of the most beautiful

places on earth. Enjoy a **Pony Ride to Baisaran Valley** or you can visit Chandanwari, Aru Valley and Betaab Valley (on your own). In the evening, drive back to Srinagar.



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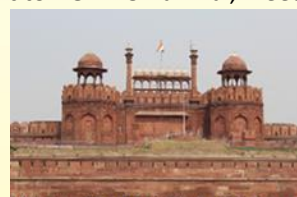
Day 5 Srinagar – Delhi

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Discover The Old Delhi



In the morning, transfer to Srinagar airport for your return domestic flight to Delhi. On arrival, meet and transfer to the hotel. You will later proceed for a sightseeing tour of Old Delhi, which begins with a visit to **Jama Masjid**, one of the largest mosques in India, with a courtyard capable of holding 25,000 devotees. The mosque has three great gates, four towers and two 40m-high minarets constructed with strips of red sandstone and white marble.



Continue tour to the **Red Fort** (photo stop), a historic palace fort of Shahjahanabad, the new capital of the fifth Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan. The Red Fort is named for its massive enclosing walls of red sandstone. Note: Red Fort is closed on Mondays. Next, you will visit **Raj Ghat**, a memorial dedicated to Mahatma Gandhi, who is revered as the Father of the Nation. It is a black marble platform that marks the spot of his cremation on the evening of January 31, 1948.

Day 6 Delhi – Agra – Delhi

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Tour Seven Wonders of the World



Early this morning, transfer to the railway station to board the **Gatimaan Express Train to Agra**, an ancient city once the capital of the Mughal empire in the 16th and 17th century. On arrival, proceed to visit the most visited world wonder **Taj Mahal**, one of the **Seven Wonders of the World**, an essential sight for all visitors to India. Standing majestically on the banks of Yamuna River, Taj Mahal is a monument of immeasurable beauty and a magnificent symbol of enduring love. This stunning white marble mausoleum was built in the

17th century by Emperor Shah Jahan in memory of his wife Mumtaz Mahal. It took approximately 22 years and an estimated 20,000 workers to build this masterpiece that reflects different colours under the canopy of sun. The purity of the white marble, the exquisite ornamentation, precious gemstones used and its picturesque location, make Taj Mahal ranks among the most popular tourist attractions in the world. Note: Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays. Thereafter, you will visit the red sandstone **Agra Fort**, a UNESCO World Heritage site with its incredible maze of courtyards, mosques and lavish private chambers reflecting the grandeur of the Mughal Empire. After the visit, transfer to the Railway Station to board the train back to Delhi.



Day 7 Delhi

(Breakfast, Dinner)

Glimpse Of New Delhi



This morning, you will proceed for a half day sightseeing tour of Delhi. You will first drive past the **Parliament House** and the **Rashtrapati Bhavan** (once the Viceroy's residence), now the official residence of the President of India, and make photo stop at **India Gate**, a war memorial located astride the Rajpath, built to commemorate the Indian soldiers who sacrificed their lives for the country during World War I. Thereafter, you will visit a UNESCO World Heritage site,

Humayun's Tomb. This magnificent garden tomb is the first substantial example of Mughal architecture in India, built in 1565. Afternoon is free for shopping and leisure activities.



Day 8 Departure from Delhi

(Breakfast)
