Day 1 Arrive in Kathmandu (Dinner)

Arrive in Kathmandu, you will be greeted by our local representative and be transferred to your hotel. Our representative will brief you about the trip and the time table. Check-in to the hotel and free & easy.

Day 2 Kathmandu – Pokhara (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Today take a long drive to Pokhara (7-8hrs), the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Pokhara is famous for breathtaking views of Mt. Fistail and Annapurna Mountain ranges and beautiful lakes. On arrival in Pokhara, check in to hotel and free time to explore the lake side area. "Pokhari " means "pond". Pokhara is a variant of Pokhari as the city has numero us ponds. Pokhara is blessed with stunning panoramic views of the Annapurna range which forms its backdrop.

Day 3 Pokhara (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Wake up early morning to take a short 30 minutes' drive to **Sarangkot** which is located at a height of 1600m. Sarangkot is renowned for its beautiful sunrise view and panoramic mountain views. We will enjoy the beautiful scenery for a while then drive back to the hotel and breakfast. Later a half day sightseeing tour of Pokhara is in store for you. We will be visiting **Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave, Davis Fall, Seti Gorge, the old town of Pokhara & Tibetan Refugee camp**. There will be **1 hour boating in Lake Fewa** to enjoy the lake

view and the mountains. After sightseeing, you can walk around lake side area, which is filled with shops, cafes & restaurants.

After breakfast drive back to Kathmandu (8-9hrs) enjoying the natural views along the way. Upon arrival, check in at the hotel and have an easy and perfectly relaxing evening. Kathmandu is a city where ancient traditions are zealously guarded while at the same time embracing modern technology. The grandeur of the past enchants the visitor whose gaze may linger on an exquisitely carved wooden window frame, an 18th century bronze sculpture or a spiritually uplifting stupa.



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Day 5 Kathmandu – Nagarkot (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



In the morning after breakfast, we will visit the **Great Stupa of Boudhanath** – UNESCO World heritage site, a vast dome-shaped monument representing the mind of the Buddha. It is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet. The history of the Stupa from its origins in the fifth century to the present day is also presented here for the first time.

Later, drive to **Bhaktapur** – UNESCO World Heritage Site. Bhaktapur is filled with monuments, mostly terra-cotta with carved wood columns, palaces and temples with elaborate carvings, gilded roofs, and open courtyards. The city is dotted with pagodas and religious shrines. The Art Gallery has a fascinating collection of ancient manuscripts, Thangkas, centuries-old stone sculpture, antique paintings that belong to the Hindu and Buddhist traditions of various periods.

After sightseeing, take a short drive to **Nagarkot** (about 1.5hrs) which is at a height of 2300 m above sea level. From this lovely scenic spot, you can catch the excellent view of the Himalayan range at sunset, even Mt. Everest on a clear day.

Day 6 Nagarkot – Kathmandu (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Wake up early in the morning for an amazing sunrise and beautiful Mountain views from your hotel. Then proceed for breakfast and enjoy the morning nature of Nagarkot. Later drive to the 2000 years old **Swoyambhunath Stupa** – UNESCO World Heritage Site also known as "Monkey temple" The temple charms with its great dazzling Stupa, while at the same time, offering a view of Kathmandu city. The two-thousand years-old Stupa is the most profound expression of Buddhist symbolism in Nepal. There's evidence to believe the

hill was used for animist rites even before Buddhism arrived in the valley two thousand years ago.

Next destination is sightseeing of **Kathmandu Durbar Square** – UNESCO World Heritage Site which is one of the major attractions in Kathmandu Valley. The word Durbar Square translated in English as Palace Complex. The Durbar Square, with its old temples and palaces, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the people. Interesting things to see here are **Kumari Ghar (The Living Goddess House)**. At the West end of the square, is a beautiful house full of woodcarving of different God and Goddesses. This Palace is three stories and, in this palace, lives the very famous living, Goddess Kumari. Both Hindus and Buddhists equally venerate her. For Hindus she is the reincarnation of Hindu Goddess Kali. She is equally worshiped by Buddhists because she is chosen from Buddhist family. This shows the harmony between Buddhist and Hindus in Nepal. In the evening proceed for **farewell dinner with cultural show**.

Day 7 Depart from Kathmandu (Breakfast)

Free & easy. Meet at hotel lobby for departure transfer to Kathmandu airport, bringing home delightful Nepal holiday with Pinnacle Travel.
