Welcome To Auckland

Day 2 Auckland – Hobbiton – Rotorua (Breakfast)



Hobbiton Movie Set Tour

Travel by coach today through rolling green farmland to the world famous **Hobbiton Movie Set**, one of New Zealand's most iconic attractions. Step into the filming locations of **The Lord of the Rings** and **The Hobbit** as your guide brings the stories to life with engaging behind the scenes insights. Stroll past the charming **Hobbit Holes**, the **Mill** and **The Green Dragon Inn**, and discover how a working farm was transformed into a richly detailed vision of Middle-earth. After your visit, enjoy a hearty lunch at the **Green Dragon Inn** before continuing to Rotorua. (Optional: Polynesian spa deluxe lake spa)

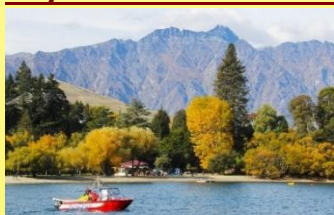
Day 3 Rotorua (Breakfast, Dinner)



Guided And Evening Experience

Rotorua is set within a captivating geothermal landscape, where steaming vents, spouting geysers, and bubbling mud pools sit alongside pristine freshwater lakes and majestic native forests. The region is also rich in **Maori** myths and legends, offering a deep cultural connection to the land (Optional: 90 minutes Rotorua city & lake duck tour). This afternoon, you will be transported to **Te Puia** for a guided tour of the **Maori Arts and Crafts Institute**, the **Kiwi Conservation Centre**, and the **geothermal valley**. Then, enjoy a traditional Hangi dinner overlooking the valley and its geysers, followed by a 40 minutes cultural performance. The evening concludes with hot chocolate and pudding on the geyser terrace.

Day 4 Rotorua – Queenstown (Breakfast)



Compact Alpine Resort Town

Depart on your domestic flight to Queenstown (Air ticket not included, approximately 3 hours flight). Nestled amid magnificent vistas and towering mountains, this compact alpine resort town is surrounded by an expansive natural landscape, it is not surprising Queenstown is often described as the Adventure Capital of the World. (Optional: skyline gondola ride + 3 luge rides, original onsen exclusive indoor pool)

Day 5 Queenstown – Milford Sound – Queenstown (Breakfast, Lunch)



Milford Sound Cruise

Fiordland is one of the world's last great wildernesses. Today's breathtaking tour takes you past mirror like lakes and cascading waterfalls into **Milford Sound**, a fiord carved by ice age glaciers and famously described as the Eighth Wonder of the World. On arrival, board your vessel for a scenic cruise through the fiord, surrounded by towering mountains and cliffs that plunge dramatically into the sea. Feel the refreshing spray of waterfalls as you glide close to sheer rock faces, before returning to shore. After a full day of awe inspiring scenery, relax on the coach ride back to downtown Queenstown.

Day 6 Queenstown – Mt. Cook – Christchurch (Breakfast)



The Lord of the Rings Scene And Lake Tekapo

Today's tour departs from Queenstown, traveling through the stunning **Kawarau Gorge** and the fruit and wine growing region of **Cromwell**. The journey follows the sparkling shores of **Lake Dunstan** before winding through the dramatic **Lindis Pass**. Continue across the vast plains of the **Mackenzie** District, passing magnificent turquoise blue lakes, framed by **Aoraki Mt. Cook** and the towering **Southern Alps**, arriving at **Mt. Cook Village** where you will have some free time to take in the scenery. Departing Mt. Cook, the landscapes reveal why many scenes from **The Lord of the Rings** were filmed nearby. Stop at the **iconic Church of the Good Shepherd**, peacefully perched on the shores of **Lake Tekapo**, before continuing through the breathtaking countryside to Christchurch.
