Day 1 Arrive in Kathmandu (Dinner)

Arrive in Kathmandu, you will be greeted by our local representative and be transferred to your hotel. Our representative will brief you about the trip and the time table. Check-in to the hotel and free & easy.

Day 2 Kathmandu – Pokhara (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Hotel check-out, take a long drive to **Pokhara** (7-8hrs), the second largest and the most beautiful city in Nepal. Pokhara is famous for breathtaking views of **Mt. Fistail** and **Annapurna Mountain** ranges and **beautiful lakes**. On arrival in Pokhara, check in to hotel and free time to explore the lake side area. "Pokhari " means "pond". Pokhara is a variant of Pokhari as the city has numerous ponds. Pokhara is blessed with stunning panoramic views of the Annapurna range which forms its backdrop.

Day 3 Pokhara (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Wake up early morning to take a short 30 minutes' drive to **Sarangkot** which is located at a height of 1600m. Sarangkot is renowned for its beautiful sunrise view and panoramic mountain views. You will enjoy the beautiful scenery for a while then drive back to the hotel and breakfast. Later a half day sightseeing tour of Pokhara is in store for you. You will be visiting **Gupteshwor Mahadev Cave, Davis Fall, Seti Gorge, the old town of Pokhara & Tibetan Refugee camp**. There will be **1 hour boating in Lake Fewa** to enjoy the lake view and the mountains. After sightseeing, you can walk around lake side area, which is filled

with shops, cafes & restaurants.

Day 4 Pokhara – Chitwan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Morning begins with a hearty breakfast then drive to **Chitwan** (about 5hrs). Chitwan offers one of **the finest wildlife experiences in Asia**. Chitwan literally means "heart of the jungle" offering lush jungles and vibrant Tharu culture. In the southwest corner of Bagmati Province, Chitwan lies between foothills of the Himalaya, the Mahabharat and Siwalik ranges. In the evening, you will enjoy **cultural show** which is known as **Tharu stick dance**.

Day 5 Chitwan (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Today you will be escorted by an expert naturalist on various exciting jungle experience including **jeep safari, canoe ride, jungle walk, birdwatching, village walk** and other nature and jungle activities. Jungles at Chitwan National Park are teeming with wild animals like tigers, leopards and rhinos, along the marshes and rivers are gharial and marsh muggers basking in the sun. In the evening you can walk around the nearby village to witness daily life of locals.

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Day 6

Chitwan – Nagarkot

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



After breakfast, return to **Kathmandu** (about 6hrs) and continue to **Nagarkot** which is at a height of 2300m above sea level. Nagarkot commands a classic panorama of the Himalayan **gorgeous mountain ranges**. You can see many major peaks of the Himalayas, like Langtang, Langtang- Lirung, Chobha Bhamre, Amadablam, Dorje Lhakpa, Gaurishankar and many peaks of the Himalayas, including Mount Everest on a clear day. Also, the views of **sunrise and sunset** are stunning from Nagarkot.

Day 7

Nagarkot – Kathmandu

(Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)



Wake up early morning and enjoy the **mesmerizing sunrise and the beautiful Himalayan Panoramas** just in front of you. Enjoy the fascinating scenery while enjoying your breakfast. You may wish to have some walk in the village side near your hotel. Then drive back to **Kathmandu** (about 1.5hrs) and continue the sightseeing tour. Proceed for sightseeing tour to **Great Stupa of Boudhanath** – UNESCO World heritage site. Boudhanath Stupa holds a great importance to the entire Buddhist around the world. The Stupa is a vast dome-shaped monument representing the mind of the Buddha, is the primary pilgrimage destination for Tantric Buddhists of the Himalayas and a major draw for Tibetan Buddhists from all over the planet. The history of the Stupa from its origins in the fifth century to the present day is also presented here for the first time.



Then visit **Kathmandu Durbar Square** – UNESCO World Heritage Site. Kathmandu Durbar Square is a historic place that was also a politically important site until recently. The Kings of Nepal were crowned, and their coronation ceremony was solemnized in this Durbar Square. The Durbar Square, with its old temples and palaces, epitomizes the religious and cultural life of the people. The temples, monuments, and palaces are believed to have been built by the Malla kings of the Medieval Nepal. In the evening proceed for **farewell dinner with cultural show**.

Day 8

Depart from Kathmandu

(Breakfast)
